

Exhibition Categories 2011

1: Bed Quilt (non-professional)

2: Bed Quilt (professional)

3: Wall Quilt (non-professional)

4: Wall Quilt (professional)

5: Mixed Media Quilt (open)

Quilt may include materials other than fabric and must include mixed techniques such as embroidery, embellishment, painting, printing, dyeing, fibre manipulation and trapunto. Must comprise at least 50% fabric and meet the definition of a quilt.

6: Art Quilt (open)

An original design with no similarity to the work of another artist. Maximum size 240cm.

7: Group Quilt (open)

Three or more people must have constructed the quilt, and at least one of the makers must be a Canberra Quilters Inc member. The quilt may be commercially quilted, that is, one of the makers may be a commercial quilter.

8: Commercially-Quilted Quilt (open)

Any quilt made by a member and quilted by a commercial quilter.

9: Challenge Quilt (open)

Response to the theme *Home*, measuring 70cm x 50cm, portrait orientation. 3cm size variation permitted.

10: Tiny Treasure Quilt (open)

No side larger than 35cm.

11: Creative Clothing - Classic

Clothing that is classic in design and incorporates at least piecing or quilting. Member may enter up to three items.

12: Creative Clothing – Art to Wear

Clothing that experiments with design, based on your own pattern or a commercial pattern, and explores textile art techniques and materials. At least two techniques are to be incorporated. Member may enter up to three items.

13: Creative Clothing – Accessories

Accessories that incorporate fabric as the main element of construction. At least two techniques are to be incorporated. Member may enter up to three items.

14: Creative Clothing – Challenge

Clothing or accessory that addresses the 2011 challenge theme, *Home*. Member may enter one item.

15: Quilts by children

For children up to and including 12 years of age. Children may enter up to three quilts each in the category, but must indicate their order of preference on the entry forms. Siblings may enter a joint quilt.

16: Quilts by youth

For children aged between 13 and 17 years of age. Children may enter up to three quilts each in the category, but must indicate their order of preference on the entry forms. Siblings may enter a joint quilt.

Bernina Best of Show is selected from the quilts awarded first place in categories 1-6.
